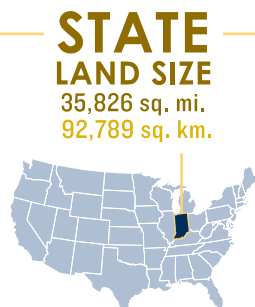

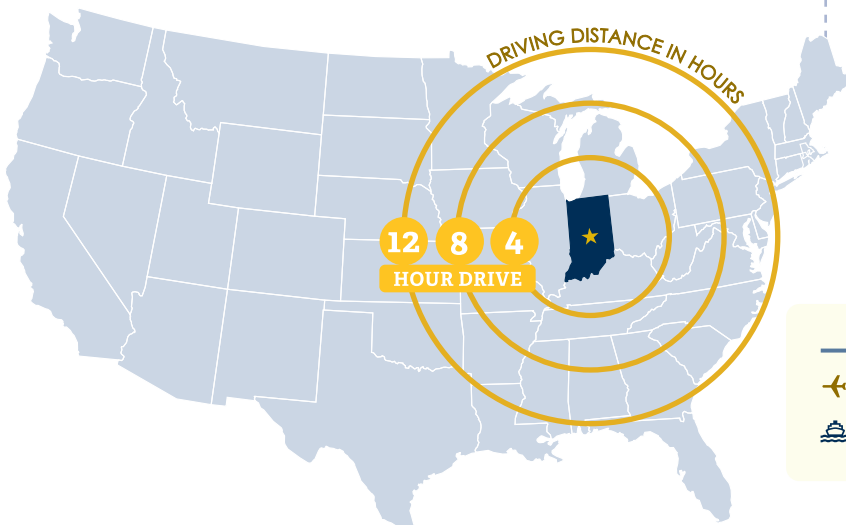

TRANSPORTATION

AIR

Indiana International Airport is the 5th in airports by landed weight of all-cargo operations and home to the 2nd largest FedEx hub in the world.

RAIL

1ST in the U.S. for rail tons of primary metal products originated and 4TH in the U.S. for total freight railroads with 41.

ROAD

National leader in the U.S. for pass-through highways

WATER

With 3 international ports and 400 miles of navigable waterways, Indiana is home to the only statewide port system providing international connections for America's Heartland via the Great Lakes and Ohio-Mississippi river system.

INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT

By the end of calendar year 2015, over \$11B will be invested in new infrastructure and preservation. An additional \$1B will be spent on road construction and bridge repair.
